

CalOMS Codes Handout

CalOMS is California’s data collection and reporting systems for substance use disorder (SUD) treatment services. Staff can find more information on How to Complete a CalOMS [Admission](#) or [Discharge](#) on CalMHSA’s site.

Code	Definition	Reason for Use
99900	Client declined to state	This value is used when the client has declined to state an answer for the question.
99901	Unknown or Not sure/Don't know	This value is used to indicate that the answer is unknown to the provider or to indicate the client response is "Not sure or don't know"
99902	None or not applicable	Indicates that the question is not applicable to the client or that the answer is "none."
99903	Other	When the client's answer is not any of the specified options provided.
99904	Client unable to answer	ONLY for developmentally disabled clients that are unable to answer the question and for clients undergoing detoxification services that have not stabilized.
00000	Homeless	Zip code at current residence field. The value 00000 must ONLY be used if Current Living Arrangements is set to Homeless.
