10	 Claiming Status: We are on our 22nd Test 837 We expect to submit a production size 837 within the next few days Unlike CATS, which only sent the primary diagnosis, Avatar submits all diagnoses, so we have had some significant cleanup in that area The state has issues with Address records containing preceding or trailing blank spaces, which has been and will continue to be a cleanup issue As we move forward with claims, we have found issues which will have to be addressed, and services with these issues will be removed from the claim until they are resolved: Missing Medi-Cal policy number Missing Diagnosis Missing Medicare policy number (for clients who also have Medi-Cal) New Service Codes- We will soon be implementing some new service codes to track non-billable services (i.e. services provided prior to a dated treatment plan). License Availability – We are currently able to handle additional license requests. If agencies have additional users who would like a license, please submit their information to Avatar@saccounty.net and we can get them scheduled for training. UMDAP Policy – Has not been formalized, but in short the decision has been made to only include household members who are known clients, except in the case where the client is a child, then the parents need to be included as well. This applies to the Family Registration tab. Fiscal Policy – As mentioned previously, services will be excluded from claiming if they are missing diagnosis or policy numbers. This will be formalized in writing soon, but it will begin immediately due to practical considerations with the claim. Website – Has been updated to reflect the inclusion of Alcohol and Drug Programs.
