	Fee override indicator –The patch has been loaded in the LIVE environment of Avatar and will be monitored over time to see if the bug has been fixed.	
	CSI –The patch has been loaded in both the TEST and LIVE environments and the dictionary values for unknown place of birth, counties should be corrected.	
	Approved Services on 99999's – There is a bug in Avatar that is resulting in approved services for zero dollars. NetSmart is working on the fix. The good news is that the problem is resolved when we process replacements on these claims. The next step will be for Fiscal to reclaim them. Providers do not need to do anything regarding these services.

	ADS – Fiscal just started working on the June 2011 claiming	
	MH - Fiscal will start working on claims tomorrow for May/June 2011	
	MH – Fiscal is currently working on Medi-Medi replacements. There have been a couple emails inquiries about replacements still showing on reports. Fiscal is only processing rehab services at this time and will move to the next batch of services once the rehab services are finished.	
	As a reminder - for all Guarantors 'customized plan' should always be set to 'no' unless the person is falling on and off Medi-Cal eligibility.	
	Denials for CO22 (OHC) – management has made the decision to process CO22 denials for claims that are within 1 year of the claim date. Claims will be resubmitted to Medi-Cal but be aware that if it is close to a year old it will more than likely be denied. Please do not send services that are 1 year old or older.	
	 ADS – The OHC timeline for replacements has been lifted for now. The delay reason codes of 1 year do apply to ADS 	
	Please don't delete Guarantors if we have already claimed services to that Guarantor. If a client falls off please just enter an end date but do not delete the Guarantor.	
	MH Reminder – Do not enter a new service until you are ready to submit a CCS. A lot of services are going out as originals instead of as replacements.	
	ADS Providers – We received guidance on how to submit a claim to the State for a minor when OHC does not need to be billed. This guidance also applies to services where we have received incorrect denials from the OHC of not Authorized. Agencies must receive letters client by client indicating this is

As reports are modified, and as new reports are developed, each report will have a "Report Version Date" link in the report footer. This link reflects the most recent change to the report, and clicking on it will open up details on:

	 Grouping considerations in the report Report revision history with explanations of what is changed with each update 	
	Reports presented at the forum (deployed on 7/22/11) and which contain the new "Revised" footer are:	
	Missing CSI by Program - Added episode admission date, added print date/time	
	<u>Missing CSI Service Information</u> – New report, reflects services in a date range which are missing the Evidence Based Practice CSI information.	
	Phase II Program Charge Status – Split the "Unbilled" group out into Open, Unbilled and Unbilled DELETE to more accurately reflect the status of the charge.	
	Provider Last Service Report – Added Service Coordinator and Last Service (All Locations)
