	 Fee override indicator – The Avatar Team has narrowed it down to 2 users that are experiencing difficulty with the fee override indicator being set. We are monitoring and working with those users to get it corrected. A CSI file has been submitted and results received. All data we are required to submit is under the error threshold except for the General Medical Conditions. The General Medical Conditions data should be entered in the Diagnosis option and has been required since 2007. If you are entering the Axis III diagnosis then you do not have to submit a General Medical Condition. Only enter one or the other. Do not enter both. At this time we are not sure yet if the data will need to be corrected. We will give you an update as soon as possible. CSI is appearing twice on the Missing CSI Service Info Report. John is working on the issue. Zero dollar approvals bug – Netsmart is working on it and do not have an update at this time. Group Code for CalWorks –the group service codes do not seem to be calculating according to Medi-cal calculations. This is because CalWORKS is not currently set up as a Medi-cal billable program so attributes specific to Medi-cal are not being applied. This is not a bug, but a set up issue.

	modifiers? A: Yes there is a cut off. Once we create the batch and start claiming if the modifier isn't entered it will not go out with our claim. If possible try to enter at the beginning of the month	
	A: We have one year from date of service but even though we have a year it could actually take longer because you have to notify fiscal by a CCS and enter the OHC info into Avatar. Then fiscal moves the service to bill the OHC. We then have to wait for adjudication from the OHC or 90 days in order to move the service back and bill Medi-Cal again. Q: Billing cycle – when entering claims and looking at modifier report is there a cut off for entering	
	Q: What is the timeline for a denial with the code CO22 (OHC)?	
	 Q. On the Duplicate Services Report there is a service showing as a duplicate but it is not a duplicate. A: Make sure there is a modifier entered on the 2nd service before it claims and you will be okay.
