We will start April after May 15th New Denial Reasons – In March of this year state/feds changed denial codes. We are working on updating our website with the new Phase II code list and the system with the new denial codes. While testing in Avatar we came across some issues. We currently have a ticket open and are working with Netsmart to get the issues resolved. In the meantime we haven't been able to post any 835s with the new denial reasons. This means that your normal denial take backs have been smaller than you would expect.
