The State is no longer requiring remote/virtual only meetings.</li> <li>The State has designated \$2.2 billion of funding to construct, acquire, and expand properties and invest in mobile crisis infrastructure related to behavioral health. The RFA was released on January 31 by the State. BHS will apply with the following three priority areas for our application: Youth Crisis, Mental Health Rehabilitation Centers, and Substance Use Disorder Residential. The deadline to apply is March 31, 2022.</li> </ul>
