<b>Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Report Ryan Quist, Director</b>	<p>Kelli Weaver, Deputy Director, Behavioral Health Services, provided the following report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Behavioral Health Bridge Housing update: We have been awarded a total of \$58 million in round 3. This program is designed to be a transition between permanent housing and unsheltered</li> </ul>

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	<p>populations. Outcomes are significantly better when we engage with clients in a sheltered environment rather than an unsheltered encampment. Bridges is one of the providers that will be able to do improvements on three of their houses.</p>

There has been a 56% decline from last year to this year.</li> <li>• November 30, 2024, National Methamphetamine Awareness Day. Center Point a 31 bed facility and Serenity a 6 bed facility will be contracting with Sacramento County and providing residential services to clients in the next few months.</li> <li>• SUPT is working with our CORE Mental Health providers to be able to provide care screenings at the CORE locations.</li> <li>• SUPT has started provider committees per modality.</li> <li>• A list of Sober Living providers with the services they offer has been created and is available as a handout at tonight's meeting.</li> </ul>
