<b>Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Report</b> <b>Ryan Quist, Director</b>	<p>May is Mental Health Awareness Month.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nationally, 43% of adults in substance use treatment have a diagnosable mental health issue.</li> <li>• Nationally, 60% of youth in substance use treatment have a diagnosable mental health issue.</li> <li>• Fentanyl Awareness Day is May 7, 2024.</li> <li>• Behavioral Health Bridge Housing Project received \$43.1 million of funding. BHS released a Letter of Interest (LOI) and received 10 proposals from six organizations and four proposals were selected to move forward. One of the projects selected has a substance use sober living environment component.</li> </ul>
