Discussion/action Item: Discuss concerns raised with planned MHB Children's System of Care Committee Parent/Youth Forums and next steps	Mental Health Board Executive Committee  Ms. Ann Arneill discussed concerns of the Chiefs of Staff with having Parent/Youth Forums. Themes included the preparedness of school systems for feedback from the MHB.  Ms. Theresa Riviera and Ms. Silvia Rodriguez provided feedback that the Supervisors have expressed support for Parent/Youth Forums to them personally, specifically that the chiefs of staff don't tell the MHB what to do, and that the MHB's loyalty is not to the Board of Supervisors or their staff. Ms. Rodriguez clarified that after she spoke with former Chair Arneill after the Chiefs of Staff meeting, it was her understanding that they supported this.  Chair Sheley communicated her understanding of the concern raised by the Chiefs of Staff was regarding scope of the MHB in procuring information regarding the school districts, as well as relationship considerations in schools getting criticism by name from parents and youth who attend them.  Ms. Rodriguez expressed that the MHB can design stakeholder input the way they want to, even if decide to mention specific schools.	12:05-12:30 pm

		Ms. Rodriguez expressed that County staff may not dictate to the MHB how they go about their research. Ms. Rodriguez requested that the minutes reflect that it was insulting to her that she needed to ask permission to do promise the community that there would be a Parent/Youth Forum.  Ms. Riviera expressed the importance of hearing from the youth themselves directly, as well as their parents.  Chair Sheley clarified that her understanding is that the Parent/Youth Forums can move forward as long as particular individuals or schools are not identified in the report. Ms. Rodriguez and Ms. Riviera agreed.  Chair Sheley moved to move forward with the Parent and Youth Forums, while not disclosing names of individuals or schools in the report of information gathered. Ms. Rodriguez seconded the motion. Ms. Arneill abstained. Motion carried.
