Meeting News

On January 21st, board members reviewed their bylaws and meeting requirements. With the State of Emergency lifted, board members must attend in-person meetings beginning this March.



To accommodate youth schedules while abiding by the Brown Act rules and regulations, members will host one monthly board meeting in person. In order to keep members well informed on Sacramento behavioral health activity, members will receive virtual trainings in groups compromised of less than half the members.
