5:08 pm Welcome and introductions

- Board members announce their presence. Quorum was not set as three members were present. BM Zauna joined at 5:13pm and quorum was set.

5:15 pm Program Updates

- MHRAS ad hoc will be focused on compiling and creating the report using all of the board members findings and data from their respective meetings. Board members will work on the compilation of data and findings individually and will discuss meeting times for creating the report in the near future. The MHRAS should include
 - Summary of last Policy Recommendation
 - Which outcomes are being met?
 - Which outcomes are under development?
 - What outcomes can not be met and why?
 - Timeline of expected programs from BOS or SCOE to implement ideas.
- Board members contacted BOS and SCOE and checked in on the status of updates. Board members updated that they have reached out to both SCOE and BOS regarding the advertisement of their resources and the status of their mental health clinicians within schools. We are going to compile this data to create the MHRAS report by the end of May ready to be published by June 2024. The following is their updates:
 - BM Zauna- Had to reschedule a meeting with Supervisor Patrick Kennedy and Constituent Affairs Representative Xochitl Gomez from Thursday, April 18th to Thursday, April 25th.
 - BM Natanya - Had a meeting with Special Assistant Forrest Johnson on behalf of Supervisor Sue Frost. - Should reach out to DHS because they understand the policy and implementation. They will reach out to Natanya in the near future. Gave suggestions that it is best to reach out to district staff and possible collaboration with Sac Youth Coalition.
 - BM Stormee - BM Stormee followed up within the email chain with Supervisor Desmond for the April 12th meeting, and tried to reach out however there was no response to her attempts to reach out.
 - BM Radha - Met with SCOE Superintendent Gordon and discussed updates on the mental health clinicians within the district's pipeline: currently have 58 clinicians, along with 15 grad clinical interns and the hope is next year to have 125 people within the pipeline. Challenges they face are dealing with stigma around mental health as well as bringing in clinicians

from diverse backgrounds. They are also working on a 'word of mouth' youth social media campaign as well.
