## 5:10 pm - Guest Presentation: Alexander Sopp - Sac County DHS- BH Alex presented on the General Budgeting and RFP Process

- Alexander Sopp presented on how the RFP/RFA process goes.
- Entities will fill out applications and have to also demonstrate and prove how they can implement the needs of the proposers.
- After applications are completed, they are sent to a third party entity to score the proposals anonymously and rank them.
- Timeline is crucial because taxpayers dollars are on the line. Even if only one application is received, the application will still be scored and determined if they are fit.
- Sac County usually has 3-4 years grant timeline
- Alex is part of the RFA/RFP Process, usually writes the scope of the programs.
  - Alex was asked how many contracts does he oversee:
    - Capitol Stars Full Service
    - River Oaks JJ
    - Capitol Stars YHN
    - Capitol Stars Peer support services APPS, CAPS, YDF
    - BHYAB
    - JJIS Juvenile Justice Sports
- Explained how suicide prevention being embedded in FIT programs include listening sessions, providing presentations, and ZIP code is a determinant of suicide risk.
- Propositions are the main source of funding sources.
- Radha asked how does the BHYAB funding source come from:
  - Explained how ¼ is SCOE, ¼ is Sacramento County DHS/BH, and
     ¼ Sutter Health
- Exhibit C: How are the funds used and dispersed

- Community can put a request in to see the scoring of the RFP/RFA process.
- Overview of MHS in Alex area of work:
  - FIT program low to moderate MH services 10-21 y/o
    - Most have multiple sites spread equally throughout sac county
    - ~ 1600 youth served
  - TBS Therapeutic Behavioral Sports-
    - Adjunct with another program
    - Coaching and guiding Behavioral Health
    - Housing misplacements, foster youth
    - 400 youth served
  - Wraparound Services
    - 3 providers
    - Just under 300 served
    - Have to be referred by CPS or probation
  - STRP- Short Term Resting Placements
    - Behavior or other extenuating factors like misplacement
    - High severity
    - FFA Foster Family Agency
  - MHSA Contracts
    - Anti bullying such as SAFEZONE SQUAD
    - Commercially Exploited Youth
- BM Karisa asked how long does the RFP + awarding process take?
  - Alex stated it can vary, for smaller bids, depending on the LOI and having the board sign off on it as that is usually the longest.
  - For larger bids, it can take longer because of errors, more opportunities for revisions or edits.
- Board coordinator declared to the board that the BHYAB will undergo a
  provider change come June 2025. A new provider will be elected on
  January 7th and until then, PRO Youth and Families is happy to assist
  in making the transition as smooth as possible.
