The Board engaged in reviewing the 10 Year Student Mental Health and Wellness Plan. Board members provided beneficial feedback and developed a work group to focus on the plan.

Jordan, karen, and Savanna will be leading the work group, with assistance from their adult ally, Bina Lefkovitz.

Board members participated in the Children's System of Care Committee meeting regarding the school-based mental health report. Members advised to prioritize wellness centers and peer support systems in school settings, as well as underserved youth. Members also stressed that mental health services should be expanded to elementary and middle schools. The Board established a work group to write a letter of support for the Children's System of Care Committee.


## **Onboarding News**
