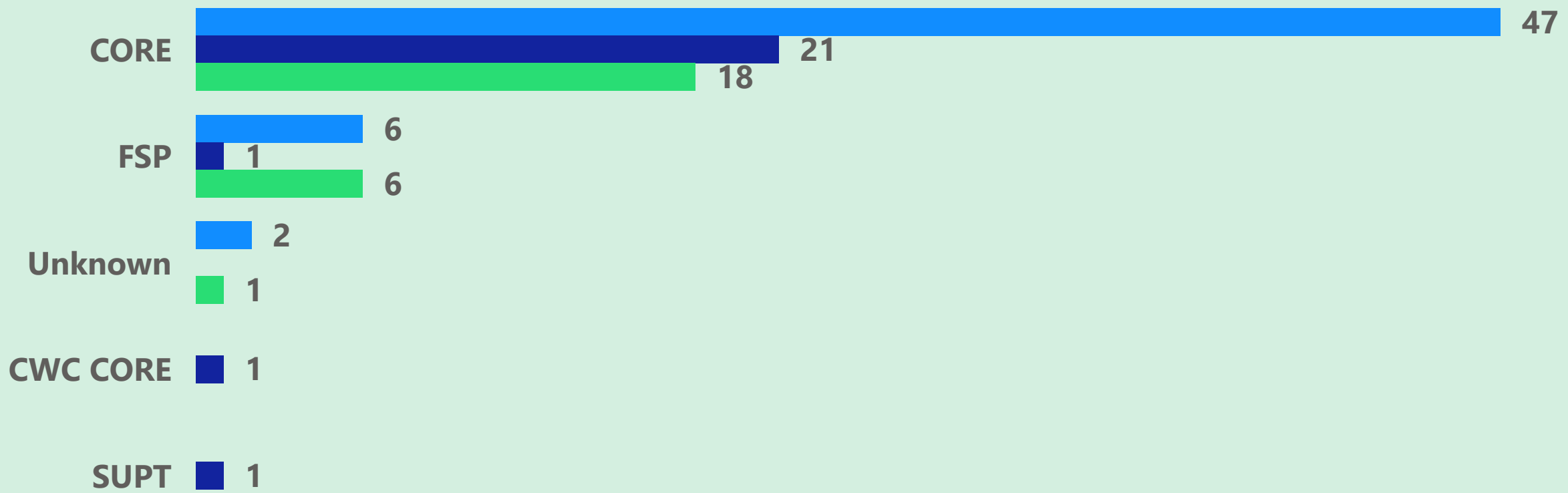
Type of Pets Sheltered

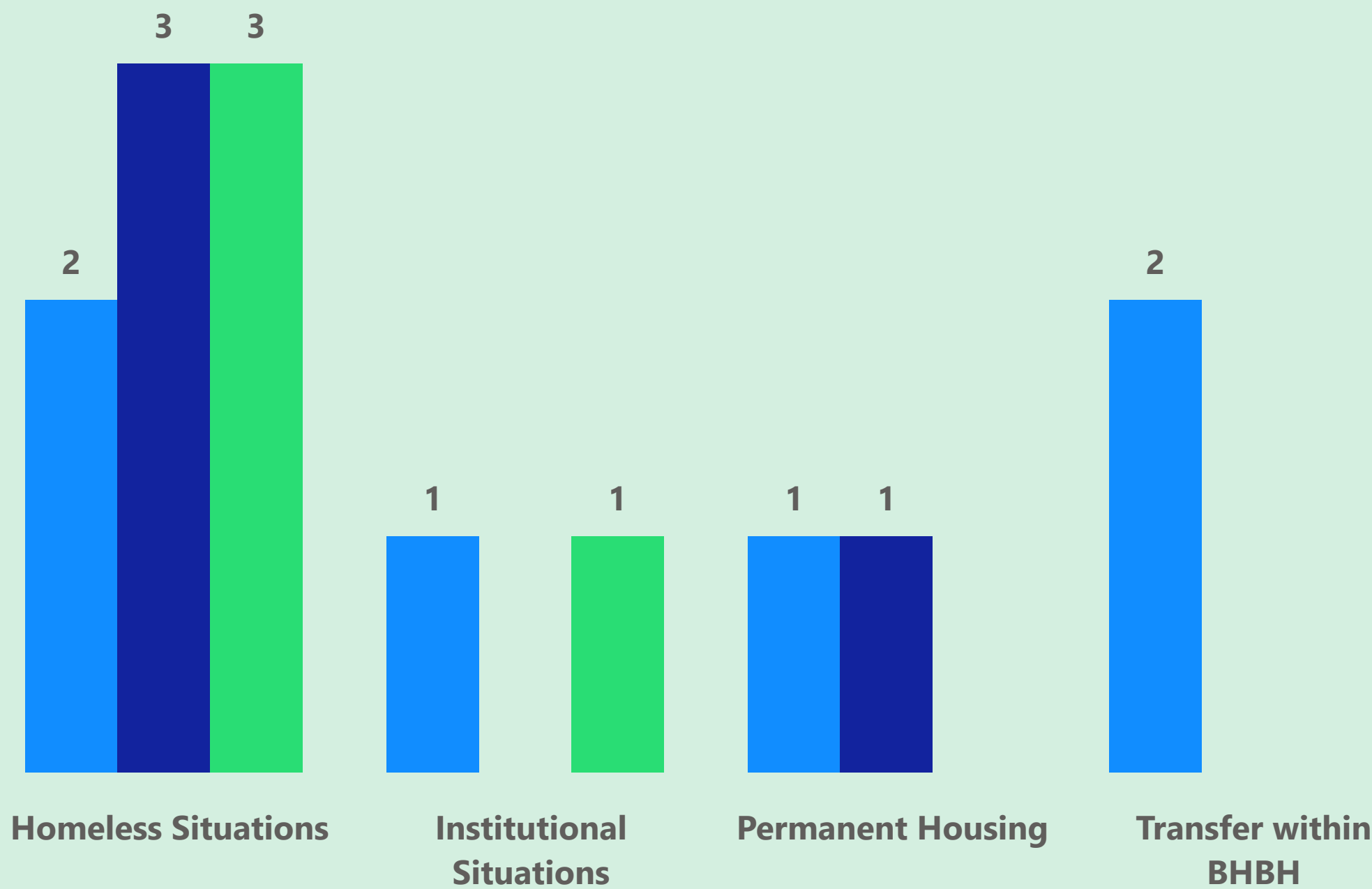
BHS Program Type at the time of Program Entry

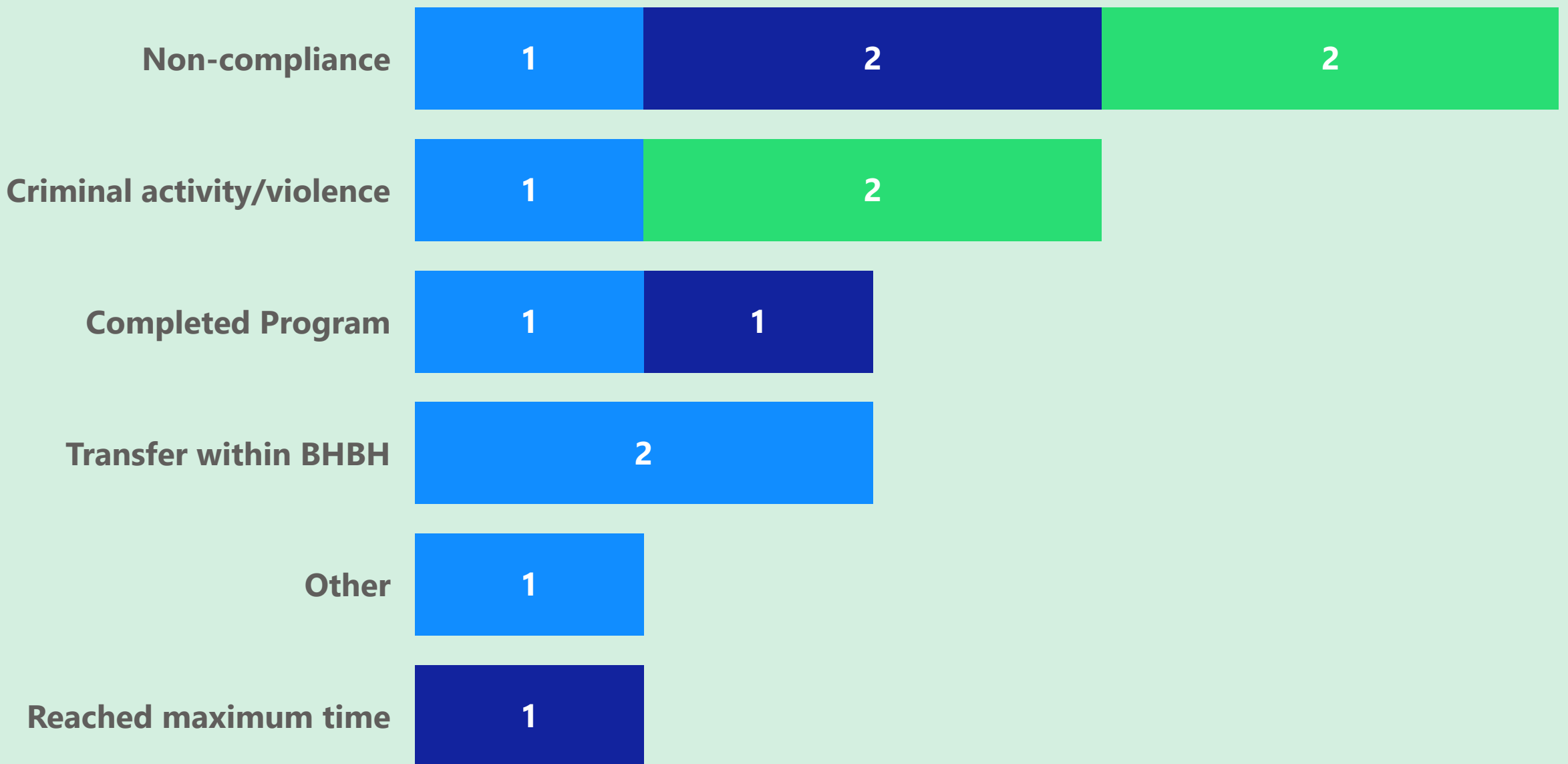
Exit Destinations

Highlights:

- *BHBH has sheltered 221 unique individuals to date in the Safe Stay Programs.
- *Sixteen people entered the program and fourteen exited during the month.

Exit Reason Changes from last month to this month:

- *Non-compliance decreased from 7 to 5
- *Completed Program increased from 1 to 2
- *Two people were transferred within BHBH to another Safe Stay

Exit Destination Changes from last month to this month:

- *Homeless situation decreased from 10 to 8
- *Permanent Housing increased from 1 to 2

BHS Program Type Definitions:

- CORE - Community Outreach Recovery Empowerment provides Outpatient Behavioral Health Services.
- CWC CORE - Community Wellness Center provides individual support and group treatment.
- FSP - Full-Service Partnership, provides high-intensity Behavioral Health Services.
- SUPT - Substance Use Prevention and Treatment provides prevention and treatment services for substance (alcohol and drug) use disorders.
