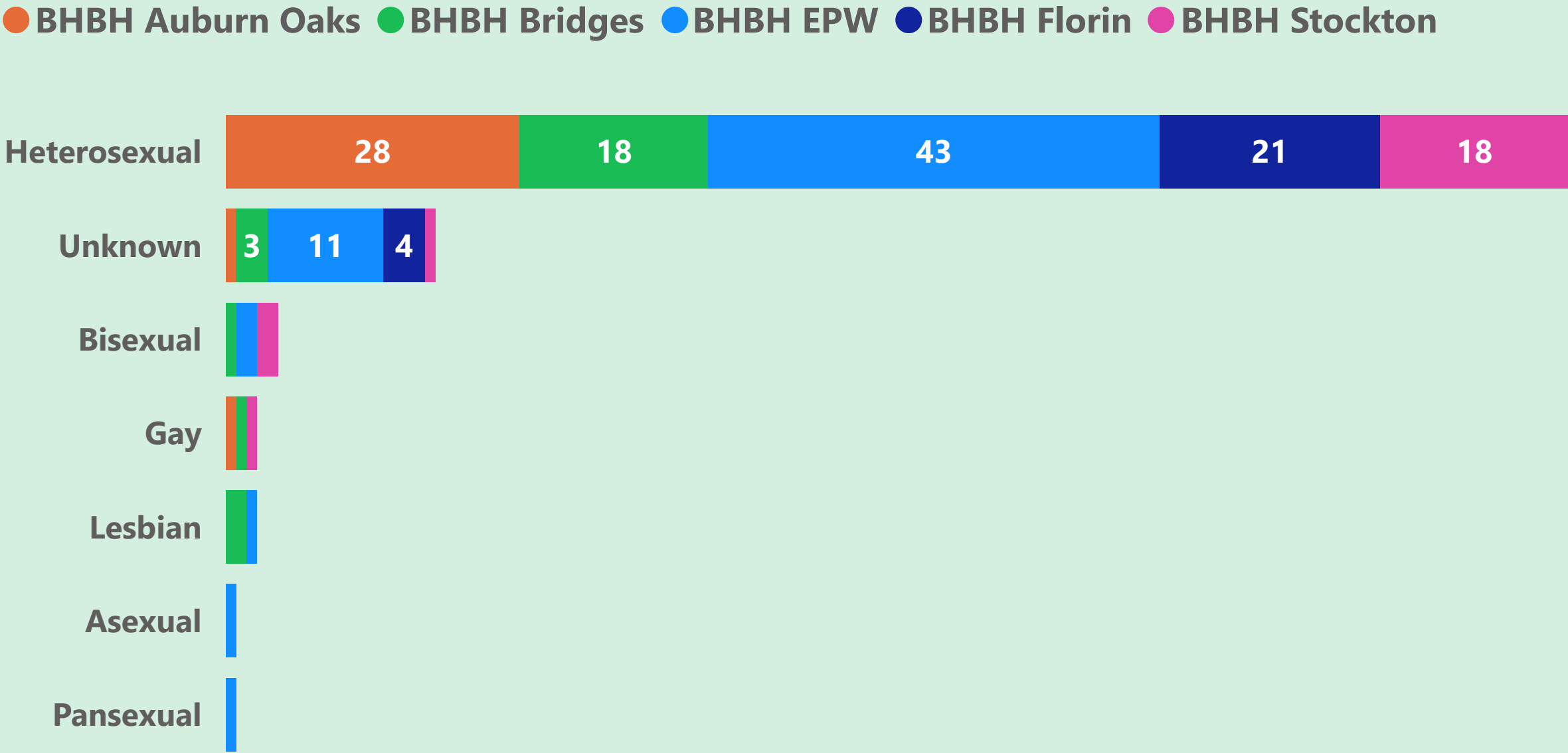
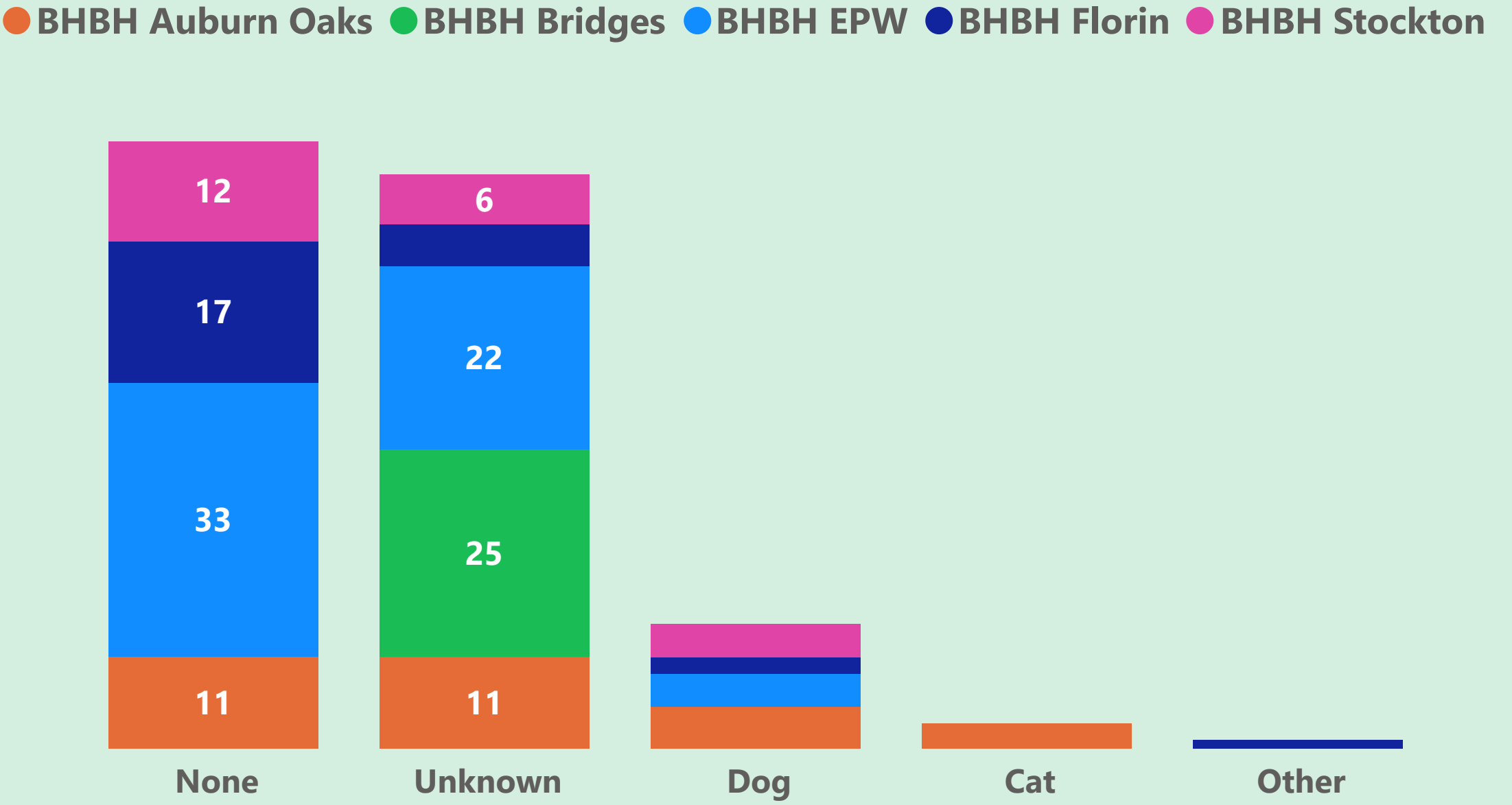


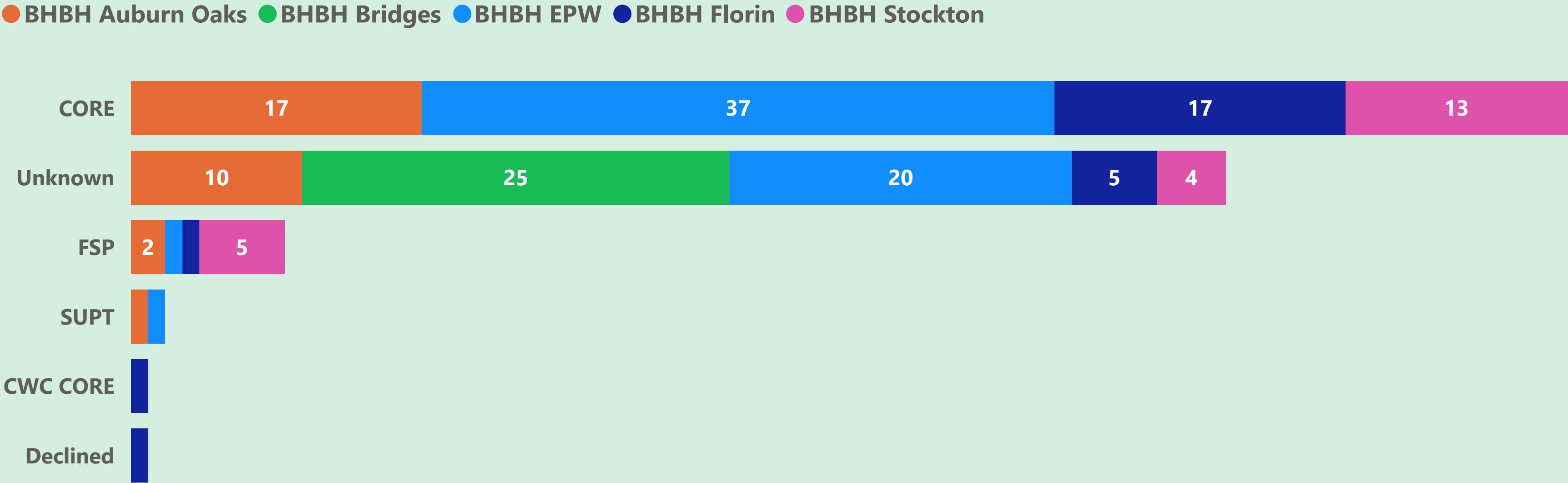

### Type of Pets Sheltered

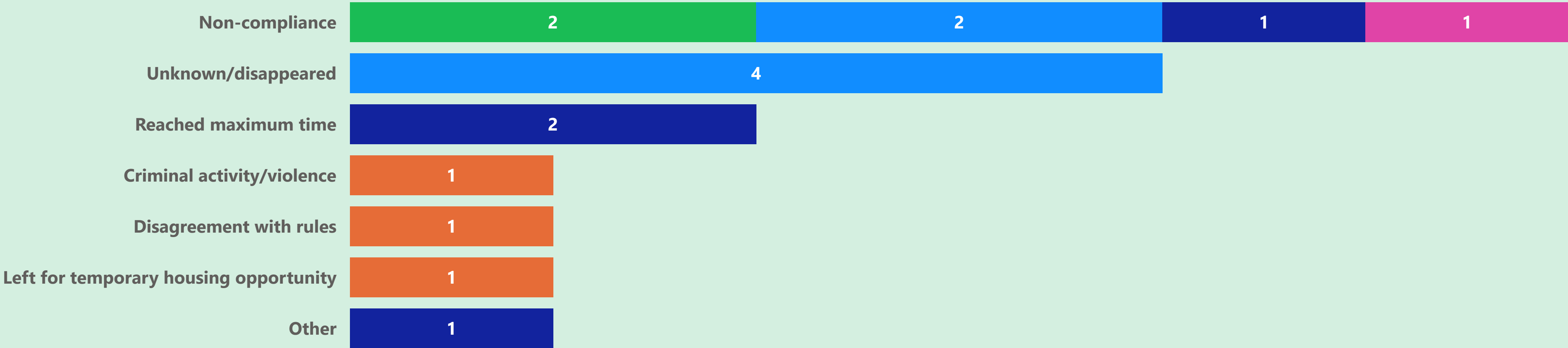


### BHS Program Type at the time of Program Entry

**Highlights:**

- \*BHBH has sheltered 317 unique individuals to date in the Safe Stay Programs. The large increase from last month is due to data entry delays.
- \*Twenty-three people entered the program and sixteen exited during the month.

**Exit Reason Changes from last month to this month:**

- \*Non-compliance decreased from 11 to 6
- \*Completed Program decreased from 4 to 0

**Exit Destination Changes from last month to this month:**

- \*Homeless situation decreased from 17 to 10
- \*Permanent Housing decreased from 4 to 1

**BHS Program Type Definitions:**

- CORE - Community Outreach Recovery Empowerment provides Outpatient Behavioral Health Services.
- CWC CORE - Community Wellness Center provides individual support and group treatment.
- FSP - Full-Service Partnership, provides high-intensity Behavioral Health Services.
- SUPT - Substance Use Prevention and Treatment provides prevention and treatment services for substance (alcohol and drug) use disorders.
