Sacramento County Division of Behavioral Health Services (BHS), in coordination with the California Institute for Behavioral Health Solutions (CIBHS), has established the Latino/Latinx/Latine/Hispanic Behavioral Health Racial Equity Learning Collaborative (L/LX/LE/H BHREC) to focus on increasing the L/LX/LE/H communities' knowledge about behavioral health conditions and services as well as co-designing adaptations to behavioral health programs with the L/LX/LE/H community to increase utilization. The Collaborative will include staff from both the Sacramento County Division of BHS, community-based organizations representing the L/LX/LE/H communities, and provider organizations. A key benefit of the BHREC is it will support BHS providers that are working toward the 24/25 Equity Incentive to co-design with the community improved practices and policies that advance equity.



WHO CAN JOIN

Provider organizations and county operated organizations that wish to co-design with the community to adapt their programs and practices to improve utilization, quality, and outcomes for the L/LX/LE/H community should join. In addition, we are still recruiting for more community organizations to join our BHREC Steering Committee.

We recommend each provider organization brings a team that includes the CEO or CEO designated staff person, a clinical supervisor, a clinician or care manager, peers or advocates, and a data analyst. One person will be designated as the lead coordinator.

PROCESS AND TIMELINE

The BHREC will meet for 6 virtual sessions. The initial session, scheduled for January 22, 2025, from 1:00 – 3:00 pm, will introduce your team to the process. The Collaborative will then work on Co-

Production Sessions with the L/LX/LE/H community on the following dates: February 4, March 4, April 1, May 6, and June 3.

- Training and technical assistance from community organizational leaders and an expert equity consultant, Koby Rodriguez.

HOW TO JOIN THE L/LX/LE/H BHREC

- 1. Discuss this option with your organization's leadership and obtain an Executive Leader Sponsorship.
- Develop your team. We recommend you include your organization's Executive Leader (CEO or designee), Key Contact, Clinical Supervisor, Clinician/Care Manager, Peers/Advocates, Data Manager. Team members can fulfil multiple roles.
- 3. Be prepared to answer the question:
 - a. Does your organization have data reports that are disaggregated by client demographics?
 - i. Your answer to this question does not determine your eligibility to join the collaborative but will support our coaches prepare to support your team.
