#### WHY MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) teaches you how to identify, understand and respond to signs of mental health and substance use challenges among adults.

### WHO CAN BENEFIT FROM KNOWING MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID?

- Caring individuals
- Caregivers
- Medical staff
- Substance Use Counselors
- Administrative/clerical staff in health/behavioral health
- First responders
- Law Enforcement

#### WHAT IT COVERS

- · Common signs and symptoms of mental health challenges.
- Common signs and symptoms of substance use challenges.
- How to interact with a person in crisis.
- How to connect a person with help.
- Expanded content on trauma, substance use and self-care.

## Learn how to respond with the Mental Health First Aid Action Plan (ALGEE):

- Assess for risk of suicide or harm.
- **Listen** nonjudgmentally.
- Give reassurance and information.
- **Encourage** appropriate professional help.
- **Encourage** self-help and other support strategies.
