Who is eligible for services?

- Individuals living in Sacramento County experiencing substance use problems.
- Eligibility is based on full-scope Medi-Cal and/or individuals who are uninsured.

Substance use treatment services are prioritized for the following individuals:

- · Pregnant and injecting drug users
- Pregnant substance users
- Injecting substance users
- Multi-system substance users (CPS, Probation, repeat legal charges, or contact with law enforcement due to offenses)
- All other substance users

Available Services:

- Outpatient Treatment/Intensive Outpatient Treatment
- Perinatal Services (pregnant and parenting women)
- Residential Treatment
- Withdrawal Management/Detoxification
- Medication-Assisted Treatment
- Sober Living Environments/Recovery Residences
- After Care Services/Recovery Support Services
