	Designed to help people prevent the onset of severe mental illness or to limit the deterioration of current functioning	Designed to help people with mental health issues maintain recovery from past episodes of significant impairment	Designed for people with severe mental illness who need ongoing multi-disciplinary treatment but do not require intensive or frequent contact	Designed for people with severe mental illness who need intensive support and treatment but need minimal support in the community	Designed for people with severe mental illness capable of living in the community but whose impairment require frequent contact and frequent support in the community	Designed for people with severe mental illness who have chronic impairment where recovery requires residential treatment in a structured community setting or semi-secured setting	Designed for people who have significant chronic impairment where recovery is minimal and a secured setting with highly structured treatment and supervision is required
