BACS' Transformative, Healing, Renewing, Inclusive, Voice, Empowerment (THRIVE) FSP program supports whole person wellness by stabilizing mental health symptoms and supporting partner-driven recovery goals.

THRIVE is a Full Service Partnership (FSP) utilizing wrap-around and intensive services to reduce barriers to wellness, incarceration and unnecessary emergency services.

## What We Do

- Provide intensive wraparound support, bringing in family, friends, community, and service team through the ACT Model
- Crisis intervention, mental health exploration, psychiatry services, case management, linkage and advocacy.
- Mark Empower partners to have a 'voice and choice' in their care and treatment.
- Community-based housing, employment services, budgeting skills, and financial support.
- Support partners in court and work with Sacramento County Behavioral Health Court.
- Support partners to thrive in the community and reduce incarceration through psychiatry, employment services, housing coordination, peer support, and more.
- "Whatever it takes" approach to stabilize and empower our partners to achieve individualized goals.
