### Sacramento County H1N1 Flu Vaccination Clinic Schedule

Sacramento County Public Health will offer FREE H1N1 Flu vaccination clinics at the following locations. The vaccine will be provided free of charge to any resident of Sacramento County who is older than six months and medically able to receive it.

Although the clinics are open to everyone, we encourage those who are at highest risk to come for a vaccination. These groups include pregnant women, healthcare workers, persons caring for children under 6 months of age, children and young adults aged 6 months to 24 years, and adults aged 24-64 with underlying medical conditions.

- These are mass-vaccination clinics, so everyone should come prepared for an outdoor wait of sixty minutes or more. It's important to dress comfortably and wear warm clothes, because it can be especially chilly at our late afternoon/evening clinics. Bring an umbrella if it looks like rain.
- Our blue-vested line monitor staff come through the line handing out clinic admission tickets and vaccine consent forms. Depending on the turnout, attendees could wait in line for awhile before the ticketing staff reaches them.
- Our line monitors make every effort to identify persons who are medically fragile or have disabilities. Such persons are invited to an indoor waiting area which has limited capacity. Anyone who fits this criteria but believes they have been overlooked is welcome to make a request to our line monitor staff.
- Each of our four-hour walk-in clinics is able to vaccinate about 2,000 people. Once clinic capacity has been reached, staff will close the line to new arrivals.
- Medical staff at the clinics will determine which flu product an attendee will receive based on Centers for Disease Control guidance and recipient's age and medical condition.

This clinic schedule may change due to vaccine availability or other factors.
