### Agenda Item

1. Welcome/Opening Remarks and Updates – Eddie Kirby, Vice-Chair

Meeting convened at 3:12 p.m. by Acting Chair, Eddie Kirby.

**2. Agenda Review** – Jenine Spotnitz, *Sacramento County Department of Health Services* 

Ms. Spotnitz reviewed the agenda and noted the following adjustments and updates:

 There would be no updates from Dr. Malhotra or the Department of Health Services Chair of the Quality Improvement/Quality Assurance and Consumer Protection Committees as both were absent.

### Agenda Item

- The Consumer Protection Committee will present its Chair Recommendation Process later in the meeting.
- The Quality Improvement/Quality Assurance Committee will present at the next rescheduled meeting, which will be moved to avoid conflict with the Thanksgiving holiday. That presentation will include draft recommendations for quantitative data measures to be requested from managed care plans, disaggregated by demographics and geography.
- Following the Commission's future vote on those recommendations, staff will reengage managed care plans to discuss feasibility and potential refinements if needed.

4. Presentation, Discussion & Action: Chair Recommendation Process – CPC Commissioners, Nick Capistrano & Margarita Dodatko Commissioner Margarita Dodatko presented the proposed process for nominating a commission chair to the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors. She noted that while the Board of Supervisors formally appoints the chair, the Commission has the opportunity to identify and nominate a candidate for appointment.

She described the process developed by the Bylaws and Governance Ad Hoc Committee and further refined by the Consumer Protection Committee (CPC). The CPC incorporated four interview questions to be answered by applicants before the full Commission to allow for a more interactive selection process. Following those presentations, the CPC will score the candidates based on the adopted criteria.

Timeline (presented by Commissioner Nicholas Capistrano):

- October 16, 2025: Commission approval process
- November 13, 2025: Statements of interest and applicant interviews
- November 21, 2025: CPC scoring of candidates
- December 2, 2025: CPC recommendation to the full Commission

Acting Chair, Eddie Kirby, thanked the presenters and recognized Commissioner Michelle Monroe for her leadership in the ad hoc committee that developed the initial process framework.

5. Presentation & Discussion: County's Response to State and Federal Medicaid Changes: Sacramento County's Medically Indigent Services Program - Courtney Maslyn, Sacramento County Department of Health Care Services

### **Discussion Summary:**

- Commissioner Courtney Maslyn provided an update on the County Medical Indigent Services Program (CMISP) and Healthy Partners framework, including initial modeling efforts to project enrollment, coverage, options, and fiscal impacts ahead of the 2026 transition.
- Discussion focused on key "policy levers" under consideration: income thresholds, cost-sharing mechanisms, asset limits, and service scope.
- Commissioners discussed balancing service levels with fiscal sustainability and the potential to coordinate resources among local hospitals and community partners.
- Commissioners emphasized the need to weigh administrative costs when considering asset or cost-sharing requirements to ensure fiscal efficiency.
- Staff confirmed that while both programs legally remain active, current enrollment is zero. Future adjustments will be data-driven and coordinated with the Board of Supervisors.
- Staff proposed sending a post-meeting survey to commissioners to gather additional input for refining program models and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors.

No action was taken. Staff will solicit Commissioner feedback after the meeting.

6. Public Comment – One comment per person, limited to two minutes

Acting Chair, Eddie Kirby, opened the floor for public comment.

One question was raised regarding oral health coverage under CMISP and Health Partners. Staff responded that CMISP provides oral health services when medically necessary and may refer to external providers or emergency care as appropriate. Healthy Partners coverage parameters will be confirmed and reported back to the Commission.

7. Closing Comments and Adjournment – Eddie Kirby, Vice-Chair

Acting Chair, Eddie Kirby, thanked staff, commissioners, and community partners for their thoughtful participation and collaboration. He emphasized the importance of continued partnership and unified messaging as the County prepares to present options to the Board of Supervisors.
