Job Statement - Sacramento County Health Authority (SCHA) Chair

SCHA Commission Bylaws¹Article V. Section 3

The Chair shall be the principal executive officer and shall provide supervision, direction, and administer leadership over the affairs of the Commission. The Chair shall act as the spokesperson of the Commission. The Chair shall prepare meeting agendas, preside at all meetings of the Commission, and carry out the policies of this Commission. The Chair may call special meetings and create standing and ad hoc advisory committees as deemed necessary. The Chair shall appoint advisory committee chairs, vice-chairs, and members from the Commission's voting membership. The Chair may serve simultaneously as an advisory committee chair. The Chair shall have the power to contract for services of planners, financial consultants, and other experts and, separate and apart therefrom, to employ such other persons as it deems necessary. The Chair shall have the power to apply for, accept and receive state, federal or local licenses, permits, grants, loans or other aid from any philanthropic organization, agency of the United States of America, or agency of the State of California necessary for the Authority's full exercise of its powers.

Desired Qualifications

- Time Commitment Ability to attend an executive committee meeting and SCHA
 meeting. In addition, the ability to commit 2-3 hours monthly to consult with the
 Department of Health Services (DHS) staff before and after SCHA.
- Stability- Ability to commit to an appointment of at least 2 years.

Applicant Statement of Interest

Applicants must weave in the following in their statement of interest.

- **Qualifications** Applicant to list out their qualifications that would make them the right candidate for the SCHA chair position.
- Identification of Personal or Business Interests Applicant must identify potentially relevant business and personal interests and how you would maintain the integrity of SCHA chair position which leads a commission that makes decisions of behalf of the county and it's residents.
- **Decision Making Process** Applicant must outline their decision-making process and should include how you reach consensus with a group to increase buy in and effectiveness.

• **Strategic Plan** – Applicant outlines their vision for the SCHA and how they would advance the SCHA strategic plan.²
