The following options represent a second set of refined proposed items based on Commissioner input and feedback from the SCHAC meeting on April 19, 2022.

Purpose of the Sacramento County Health Authority Commission

(based on the ordinance of the Sacramento County Code relating to the Sacramento County Health Authority)

The Sacramento County Health Authority Commission shall serve the public interest of Medi-Cal beneficiaries in the county, and strive to improve health care quality, to better integrate the services of Medi-Cal managed care plans and behavioral health and oral health services, to promote prevention and wellness, to ensure the provision of cost-effective health and mental health care services, and to reduce health disparities.

1. VISION STATEMENT

Vision --- Our Desired Future

- Look beyond the life of the strategic plan, often 20-30 years out
- Audacious aspirations or dreams that may never be achieved
- Success often dependent upon the actions of multiple organizations

Proposed VISION STATEMENT Options:

1. A healthy community with access to equitable, high quality and coordinated whole person health care when and where it is needed.
2. Sacramento County's Health Authority Commission envisions a future where all people in the county get their health needs met in a dignified, equitable, respectful and coordinated way.
3. We have improved the health and well-being of Sacramento County Medi-Cal members through accessible, equitable, coordinated, whole person care.



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2. MISSION STATEMENT

1. The SCHA is a state leader in collaboratively driving quality, innovation, integration and equity for the rich diversity of Sacramento's Medi-Cal members.
2. The SCHA uses its diversity of experience and expertise to advocate for the highest quality, integrated health care for Medi-Cal beneficiaries in Sacramento through influence and oversight of the Medi-Cal system in the County to improve health outcomes and reduce health disparities.
3. SCHA is focused on ensuring access to quality and integrated health care for Medi-Cal beneficiaries in Sacramento County through collaboration and continuous oversight of the Medi-Cal system to improve health outcomes.

3. ORGANIZATIONAL VALUES

Values --- *Who We Are*

Proposed ORGANIZATIONAL VALUES:

We do our best for Sacramento's Medi-Cal managed care members by being:

- People-focused:** helping empower people to define their health and receive care on their own terms

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- Honest, respectful and high integrity:** being responsive and continuously learning
- Transparent** by using and sharing data to inform decisions and make positive changes
- Accountable in our oversight role:** holding managed care plans, delegated entities and providers to quality, access and equity standards while reducing health inequalities

4. DRAFT STRATEGIC PRIORITIES 2022-2024

1. Increase oversight and coordination to ensure that Medi-Cal managed care health plans offer services that are timely, high quality and integrated
2. Proactively prepare and respond to CalAIM and other key DHCS initiatives
3. Support efforts to improve quality of care and timely access to health care services
4. Prepare for successful transition to fewer Medi-Cal managed care health plans
5. Improve Health Authority processes and role clarity
6. Engage Medi-Cal beneficiaries in defining and improving health provider/ health plan performance and reducing health disparities
