Get to know the CCS Team

CCS Medical Case Management Nurse

Your child's nurse can help coordinate and advocate for your child's medical care. Call CCS Sacramento County office 916.875.9900 and ask to speak to your nurse if you are having any problems getting appointments, medications or supplies.



CCS Health Service Coordinator

Your Health Service Coordinator determines financial and residential eligibility. They also provide guidance on Medi-Cal issues. Call CCS Sacramento County Office at 916.875.9900 and ask to speak to your Health Service Coordinator if you are having any Medi-Cal issues or concerns.

Medical Therapy Program

Your Medical Therapy Program (MTP) staff provides occupational and physical therapy services to children and youth with certain long term physical disabilities that meet the State's eligibility criteria. If your child is part of the MTP, call and ask to speak to your therapist if you are having any therapy or equipment issues or concerns.

Accessible Pools

The Pannell Meadowview Community Center Pool is open June through August. The pool is fully accessible and includes on-site changing rooms. "Aqua Chairs" are available for people that use wheelchairs to transfer into to make entering and exiting the pool a breeze. The pool has a beach (zero) entry. There is ample free accessible parking.



For those that would like to enjoy our other pools independently, lifts are also available at Clunie, Doyle, Johnston, McClatchy Park, Natomas High School, and George Sim pools.

Swim Classes

Access Aquatics swim lessons are available at Clunie, Doyle and Pannell Meadowview pools during the summer. Classes are open to children, teens and adults of all abilities. Access Aquatics welcomes and encourages injured, ill or wounded veterans that would like to join in the fun and get in "the swim of things" at one of our fine classes. In this episode, host Juliana Urtubey breaks down some key terms and explains the legal rights that come with an IEP, or Individualized Education Program.



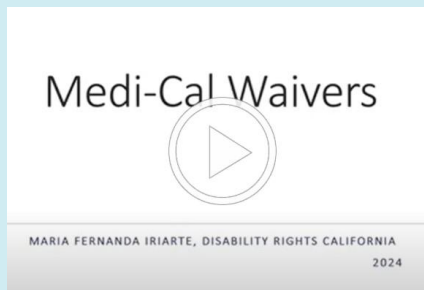
