

COVID-19 REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Situational Awareness

Sacramento County Public Health (SCPH) has seen a rise in the number of COVID-19 cases in the recent weeks with cases surpassing the initial peak at Week 14 (ending 4/4/20). In order to contain the spread of the virus, SCPH conducts both case and contact investigations and rely on the information from health care providers to do so.

SCPH is requiring all health care providers to do the following:


1. **Report all** positive cases to SCPH by:
 - [CalREDIE Provider Portal](#) OR
 - Completing the [COVID-19 CMR](#) and faxing securely to (916) 854- 9709
2. **Complete all** requested information, including but not limited to:
 - Demographics (name, date of birth, age, gender, race/ethnicity)
 - **Contact information (address, phone number)***
 - Close contact with laboratory confirmed case
 - Occupation, especially if health care worker (hospital or congregate facility) or emergency medical services
 - Symptoms, including onset date
 - Hospitalization status, including ICU
 - Underlying conditions and risk factors
 - Laboratory testing information
 - Provider information
3. **Provide all** documentation:
 - Positive laboratory report
 - Medical records for hospitalized cases, including history and physical and discharge summary

*We will not reach out to cases that do not have contact information.
