How can CCS help you?

Your CCS nurse helps to coordinate and advocate for your child's or youth's medical care.

Call and ask to speak to your nurse if you are having any problems getting appointments,

medications or supplies.

Your CCS clerical staff determine financial and residential eligibility as well as provide information and guidance for Medi-Cal issues.

Call and ask to speak to your clerical staff if you are having any Medi-Cal issues or concerns.

Your Medical Therapy Program (MTP) staff provide occupational therapy and physical therapy services to children and youth with certain long term physical disabilities that meet the State's eligibility criteria.

If your child is part of the MTP, call and ask to speak to your therapist if you are having any

therapy or equipment issues or concerns.
