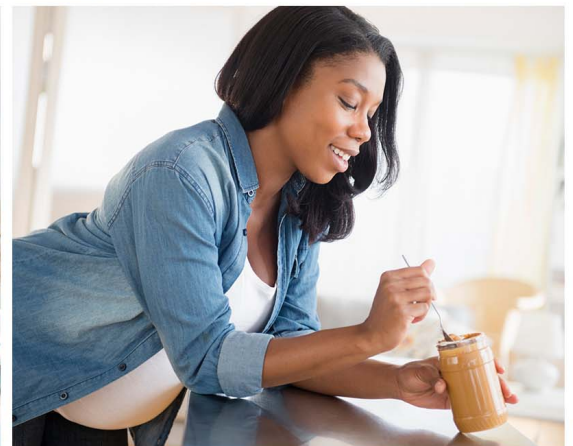

Introduction

Sacramento County Public Health’s goal is to provide equal access for all adults, children, and their families to appropriate and needed care within an integrated and seamless system. The Comprehensive Perinatal Services Program (CPSP) is a voluntary program that seeks to improve the health of low-income pregnant individuals and give their babies a healthy start in life. Sacramento County has 11 certified CPSP providers in fee-for-service and managed care systems. Practitioners include physicians, nurse midwives, physician assistants, nurses, social workers, health educators, nutritionists, and comprehensive perinatal health workers.

Sacramento County Public Health created the Sacramento County Pregnancy Resource Guide to assist CPSP providers and community-based organizations (CBOs) serving pregnant individuals with the resources and referrals needed to provide integrated care.

All certified CPSP providers are listed first for reference. The resource guide is organized by categories of resources, sub-categories of resources, and alphabetized by the organization’s name. Each resource follows the format below:
