IMMUNIZATION REPORTING

Annual immunization assessment reporting for the 2023- 2024 school year is now open! The deadline is December 1, 2023 and individuals are encouraged to report early. <u>California</u> <u>Health and Safety Code Section 120375 and</u> <u>California Code of Regulations Section 6075</u> require all child care facilities and schools (including home schools) to review student immunization records and report annually on the immunization status of their students. This year, facilities and schools will need to report the immunization status of children in:

- Pre-kindergarten/child care (ages 2-5 years)
- TK/K (not 1st grade)
- 7th grade (not 8th grade).

The reporting website has moved to the <u>CAIR</u> <u>Hub</u>. You will need to:

1. register for a CAIR Hub account (SCRL users already have one)

2. set up a user profile

3. log in to CAIR Hub to report using the Immunization Reporting application on your dashboard.

CDPH website offers <u>free online training</u> for schools TK–12th grades. These interactive modules are designed to support your efforts in implementing school immunization requirements.

ISSUE 1: OCTOBER 2023

POLIO

Only trivalent OPV (tOPV) counts toward the U.S. vaccination requirements. Doses of OPV administered before April 1, 2016, should be counted (unless specifically noted as administered during a campaign). Doses of OPV administered on or after April 1, 2016, should not be counted. Read more about this on the ACIP schedule under the polio notes.

Immunization Registry Now Required!

COVID-19

As of 9/11/23, bivalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized in the United States. The updated monovalent 2023-2024 COVID-19 vaccines are formulated to closely target currently circulating variants and provide better protection against serious consequences of COVID-19. The CDC recommends individuals 6 months and older receive an updated vaccine. Please see the new schedule here and the new product guide here. As the vaccine is now commercialized, it is recommended providers recommend and offer the updated COVID-19 vaccine to protect their patients. Uninsured and under-insured (insurance does not include coverage for vaccines or only select vaccines) adults are eligible to receive the vaccine at no cost through the Bridge Access Program and children are eligible through the Vaccines for Children Program. FLU RECOMMENDATIONS

Routine annual influenza vaccination of all persons aged ≥6 months who do not have contraindications is recommended. For most persons who need only 1 dose of influenza vaccine for the season, vaccination should ideally be offered during September or October. However, vaccination should continue after October and throughout the influenza season as long as influenza viruses are circulating, and unexpired vaccine is available.
