Public Health Officer's Report	<p>Presented by Leesa Hooks on behalf of Dr. Kasiryee Advisories have been issued:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Influenza Health Advisory was sent out last week on the masking mandate effective November 1, 2018 for health care workers with direct patient contact who have not been immunized. • Please note Health Advisory that was sent out mid-October on congenital syphilis. It encourages testing, and treatment of sexually transmitted infections. • Public Health has been working on a pilot project to start STD screening/treatment and reproductive health services at Los Rios school district particularly at two campuses – Sacramento City College and Cosumnes River College. There will be a part time NP and MA to work one day per week at each campus. We hope to start either next month or January of next year. The project is funded for one year but we hope to extend the services.
MCAH Update Leesa Hooks	<p>Presented by Leesa Hooks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • MCAH will receive additional funding for the Perinatal Equity Initiative efforts. This money will be used for planning to address the persistent disparities in African American birth outcomes. Future listening groups will be held in Sacramento County. We will be working with the MCAH board to get input. • Virtual Dental Homes are up and running however parents opting in is a slow process. The list of schools was shared with all board members encouraging anyone who has involvement with families in any of the identified schools in Twin Rivers school district to discuss benefits of VDH and encourage opting in. • BIH is undergoing some restructuring to increase enrollment and participation. More details to follow at the January meeting.

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<p>Sac County Oral Health Program Needs Assessment</p>	<p>Presented by Jan Resler</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Oral Health Needs Assessment performed by Barbara Aved Associates, 2018 • 25-37 percent of Sacramento preschool children screened showed evidence of decay • Over 6, 000 emergency department visits made for preventable dental conditions in 2016-2017 • Utilization rates (Annual Dental Visit) in 2016-2017 for eligible geographic managed dental care beneficiaries aged 0 -20 was 36.3 – 40.7 percent. For adults aged 21+ during the same time period, it was 15.2 – 21.2 percent • During 2015-2016, only 37.1 percent of Sacramento County women with a recent live birth made a dental visit during pregnancy • Dental sealants, an evidence-based preventive measure, are grossly under-utilized according to geographic managed care and commercial dental insurance data • 65 percent of Sacramento County has fluoridated drinking water • The Sacramento County Public Health – Oral Health Program, through funding from Proposition 56 and the State Department of Public Health will focus surveillance, education, advocacy efforts in the following areas: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ School-based/linked fluoride varnish and dental sealant programs; ○ Increased fluoridated community water systems; ○ Compliance with the Kindergarten Oral Health Assessment reporting requirement; ○ Increased use of fluoride varnish in non-dental healthcare settings; ○ Tobacco cessation and sugar-sweetened beverage guidance in dental offices; ○ Oral health literacy outreach to pregnant and perinatal women and the healthcare providers that serve them

Newborns, rise in Calif by 30%, in the USA 44% • 454 cases in Sacramento rank #13 in California • Congenital Syphilis 6 cases. Ranked #18 in states • Increased ads awareness, public awareness in movie theaters, I Know phone line. • Increased internal staff training • General populations- providers, homeless and users
