




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
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TOP PUBLIC HEALTH CONDITIONS – YEARS OF LIFE LOST IN 2020





TRENDS IN DEATHS – AGE ADJUSTED DEATH RATE 2000 - 2020




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


TRENDS IN TOP PUBLIC HEALTH CONDITIONS (BY BROAD CONDITION GROUPS), 2000-2020






TOP 5 CAUSES OF DEATH AND YEARS OF LIFE LOST IN 2021






RACE/ETHNICITY ALL-CAUSE MORTALITY RATE DISPARITY, 2000-2020
