COVID-19

- State and local COVID-19 emergencies have ended
- Remaining CDPH COVID-19 Health Officer Orders ended, effective 4/3/2023
- Some health care settings may continue masking requirements on their own
- SCPH continues to monitor COVID and will alert the public of significant developments
- Continue to recommend masking in crowded public settings and on public transportation and to stay home when sick
- Changes to federal coverage for vaccine and treatment are expected

Multi-Drug Resistant Organisms

- Increases in California and locally
- Some outbreaks in long term care facilities in Southern California
- A few cases have occurred locally

- When Dr. Kasirye was hired as Health Officer over a decade ago, PHAB identified achieving Public Health Accreditation as a priority and she is committed to seeing that through
- Public Health now has dedicated staff working towards achieving accreditation, which requires them to demonstrate how they meet a series of national standards
- Some funding streams are tied to accreditation requirements, including a Community Health Assessment and Community Health Improvement Plan
- Public Health developed a Strategic Plan prior to COVID-19 and will be updating next year
- PHAB members will have an opportunities to provide input on suggested adjustments as the Strategic Plan is renewed
