July PHAB Meeting and Exec Meeting Recap

County partners provided updated at the meeting. There was also a brief discussion on the Grants Pass Supreme Court decision

• Adult Correctional Health (ACH) CalAIM Readiness Assessment

- On January 26, 2023, California approved a targeted set of Medicaid services to youth and eligible adults in state prisons, county jails, and youth correctional facilities.
- State law and Section 1115 gives waiver and expenditure authority to the California Department of Healthcare Services. It requires all California prisons, jails, and youth correctional facilities to implement a 90-day pre-release services program.
- All California correctional facilities are required to submit a readiness assessment between October 1, 2024, and no later than October 1 2026 that evaluates correctional facilities' ability to meet the waiver program requirements. California Department of Healthcare Services released a Readiness Assessment template that correctional health facilities can use to complete the assessment.
- The CalAIM 90-day pre-release services program will allow ACH to bill for medications to help cover the cost of providing medications.

Integration Between Access and Substance Use Prevention Treatment Programs

- Behavioral Health Services is integrating mental health and substance use services. The department is now Behavioral Health Services Screening and Coordination (BHS SAC). County residents can access mental health or substance use services with one phone call.
- Residents can request services via calling, mail fax, and an online portal.
- Individuals who call for services go through the initial screening process to determine the best program of care for their needs.
- Services provided through BHS-SAC include:
 - Mental health and substance abuse outpatient services
 - Residential treatment
 - Recovery Residences/Sober Living Environments
 - Care Coordination
 - Crisis Intervention

- Medication Assisted Treatment
- Therapy Rehabilitation Services and Groups
- Driving Under the Influence Programs
