## County of Sacramento Emergency Medical Services Agency Approval of ProTransport-1 Ground Ambulance Fee Schedule Effective 11/1/2024

The County of Sacramento Emergency Medical Services Agency approves the ProTransport-1 Ground Ambulance Fee Schedule, Effective November 1, 2024. The Fees are listed below.

- Basic Life Support Ground Ambulance Transport, Non-Emergency \$3,050.00
- Basic Life Support Ground Ambulance Transport, Emergency \$4,600.00
- Advanced Life Support Ground Ambulance Transport, Non-Emergency \$5,050.00
- Advanced Life Support Ground Ambulance Transport, Emergency \$5,540.00
- Specialty Care Ground Ambulance Transport\*\* \$14,500.00
- Ground Ambulance Mileage, Per Mile, all levels of service, \$78.00. Mileage is reported in tenths of a mile and is billed at the next mile up. (Example: 4.2 miles would be billed as 5.0 miles).
- Ancillary charges such as oxygen, nighttime, and wait time are not billed separately.
- \*\* Note that Specialty Care Ground Ambulance Transport may include adult specialty care transport (sometimes called Critical Care Transport), Pediatric Intensive Care Transport, or Neonatal Intensive Care Transport.
