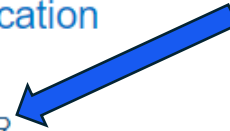

You will use the Online Application Portal to update your personal information, apply for certification, accreditation, or authorization. The portal uses the email address in your account as the primary

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Active Sacramento County EMS/MICN Personnel

If you are currently certified, accredited, or authorized as a Paramedic, MICN or Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) in Sacramento County, log in to your existing account below. Please do not create a new account. **Duplicate accounts will be deleted.**

If you are attempting to claim your ImageTrend account for the first time, select the "Forgot Username" link below and enter your Date of birth, Last Name and Social Security Number. If the data matches our records, an email will be sent to the address in your account. In this email, you will be able to reset your password and being the application process.

To login to your account, enter your First Initial Last Name as your USER ID and enter your password. If you don't know your password, select the "Forgot Password" feature by the login fields below. If you are unable to reset your password online, please contact the Sacramento County EMS Agency at 916-875-9753 for account assistance.
