

Subject: Certifications

In order to maintain Sacramento County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SCEMSA) accreditation/certification, all Paramedics, Emergency Medical Technicians and Emergency Medical Responders must keep all required certifications current at all times during the two-year Sacramento County Accreditation/Certification period. A lapse of any required certification at any time may result in an inability to work. SCEMSA reserves the right to verify an employee's required certifications at any given time.
