Purpose:

To standardize data elements collected from designated trauma care facilities to monitor, review, evaluate, and improve the delivery of prehospital advanced life support and hospital trauma care services.

Authority:

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9

Policy:

- A. Data Elements to be collected must match the National Trauma Data Standard Data Elements for submission of trauma registry data to the NTDB and the Image Trend Patient Registry™.
- B. Data shall be submitted no later than 90 days following the end of the quarter. Non-compliance with the data requirements can lead to program suspension.
