What is a STD?

A sexually transmitted disease (STD) that occurs during vaginal, anal or oral sex and also can be spread by contact with infected blood.

You can get A STD by having sex with someone who is infected.

MOST people with STDs DO NOT KNOW they are infected.

STDs can lead to serious health problems if left untreated.

Health problems for Women and Men:

- Sores bumps and blisters near your penis/vagina, anus or mouth.
- Burning pain when you urinate (pee) or have a bowel movement.
- Swelling in your groin and are around your sex organs.

Protect Yourself:

ABSTINENCE -

Don't have sex !!

SAFER SEX -

If you do have sex (vaginal, anal or oral) use a latex or polyurethane condom or dental dam.

KNOW YOUR PARTNER -

Make sure your partner does not have any STDs, and has sex only with you.



Get Tested!

- See your doctor or visit a local health clinic
- Most tests only require a urine (pee) sample and can be anonymous
- · Ask your partner to get tested
