Looking for a career with the WIC Program? The Sacramento County Department of Health Services, WIC Program has a full time position for a registered dietitian. This is a large program serving over 21,000 diverse participants in the Sacramento area.

Location: Rancho Cordova (other locations may include offices in Oak Park, Del Paso Heights,

Florin and Elk Grove)

Rate: \$31.28 per hour, plus benefits

The WIC Registered Dietitian:

- Screens program applicants to determine eligibility; evaluates nutritional status; develops nutrition care plans; provides nutrition counseling to high-risk and normal-risk program participants; provides basic breastfeeding support; connects families to community resources.
- Serves as WIC clinic lead overseeing 5-20 staff members who provide nutrition education services; manages clinic flow and resolves problems to provide optimal customer service.
- Develops nutrition classes, nutrition education materials and lesson plans.
- Develops and conducts in-service training for professional and para-professional staff.
- Coaches, trains and mentors staff, new hires, nutrition students, dietetic interns and volunteers.
- Provides medical nutrition therapy for patients at the Sacramento County Mental Health Treatment Center.

Requirements:

• Must be Registered Dietitian or registration eligible. If registration eligible, RD exam must be passed within 6 months of hire.

Preference:

- Fluent in any of the following languages: Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Farsi.
- Proficient in using Microsoft Office (Excel, Word, Outlook, PowerPoint) and virtual platforms
