- Complete the "Open Charges Deletion Request"
- Be sure to include "Contact Information" in the top right of the form in case ADS staff have questions
- "Reasons for Deletion" codes are described on the second tab of the form
- Providers are to complete all columns except the gray shaded columns (i.e. "Processing Status" and "Date Processed")
- Forms with missing or incorrect data may be returned to provider for correction and resubmission
- Encrypt and submit the OCDR form electronically to <u>SUPT-OCDR@saccounty.net</u> (Please ensure to use password protected, zipped file)
- SUPT staff will process the OCDR form, complete the shaded columns with the date and status of each line item, and return to the form to the contact listed at the top of the form

In some cases, Avatar allows providers to use the "Edit Service Option" to correct errors. This function remains available to providers. Charges that do not require deletion but can be fixed using the "Edit Service Option" will be returned to the contact person listed on the form for correction.
