The presentation included a discussion about similar language but different meanings used by criminal justice staff and treatment providers.</p> <p><b>Prevention Committee</b> Meetings have been focusing on increasing awareness about Fentanyl poisonings. The next meeting is Tuesday, February 15, 2022. Additional topics for upcoming meetings include Omni presentations and developing 2022 Committee Goals.</p> <p><b>Treatment Committee</b> At the January 19, 2022 Treatment Committee meeting, CalAIM Enhanced Care Management services for high service utilizers (MH and/or substance use) were discussed. The Committee also discussed the Contingency Management (CM) pilot program with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). The pilot project is aimed at stimulant use disorders (meth, cocaine etc.) and the use of CM (incentives) to motivate clients. The</p>

We are seeing a drop in the number of cases, but to put it into context, this is the same level we were at during our worst, earlier in the pandemic. COVID outbreaks are having a huge impact on our provider network. Dr. Quist expressed his thanks to providers for their their resiliency and continuing to serve our community. We know it's been especially challenging for our residential providers and their ability to continue admissions.</li> <li>• Dr. Quest announced the following cultural celebrations and cultural observances:</li> <li>• February is Black History Month and Ebony Chambers, Stanford Sierra Youth and Families and Michael Lynch, Improve Your Tomorrow were included in the <a href="#">Sacramento Bee top 25 Black Change Makers</a></li> <li>• February 1 is Lunar New Year, which is one of the most valued holiday for many Asian cultures.
