Central Region:

Supporting Individuals - administered by Regional Partnerships

2020-2025 WET Five Year Plan Program Framework (cont'd)

Fiscal Year 2019-20 budget includes

- Approximately \$40 million to fund county MHSA WET programs statewide through Regional Partnership Grants
 - County behavioral health agencies must collectively provide a 33% match or \$13.2 million to CalMHSA by 2025



2020-2025 WET Five Year Plan Program Framework (cont'd)

- Regional Partnerships would apply for grants in order to implement one or more of the programs that support individuals
- Sacramento is part of the Central Region
- Based on current MHSA allocation formula, Sacramento County's match would be \$430,794
- Sacramento County would receive, at minimum, this same amount of funding from the amount awarded to the Central Region Partnership during the 2020-2025 grant period



2020-2025 WET Five Year Plan Program Framework (cont'd)

BHS is asking for MHSA Steering Committee support to:

Contribute \$430,794 in WET funding to CalMHSA as our local match to ensure our ability to access grants awarded to the Central Regional Partnership during the 2020-2025 grant period.
