| 2:10 | New DHCS Requirements Under CalAIM                 | Presented by Pacific Consulting Group (recorded presentation)  Viewing of recorded presentation from Pacific Consulting group outlining the CalAIM requirements originally presented to the Health Authority Commission. Significant changes for health plans on the horizon including:  Intensive care management for high risk groups  Coordination between County and health plans  Health plans and sub-contractors will have to meet quality benchmarks & requirements as set by DHCS with sanctions and surrender of profits if benchmarks are not met  Public posting of quality improvement and health equity plans, financial data and annual survey results  Increased community investment required  Focus areas where health plans will be held accountable include behavioral health integration, maternal outcomes, housing and homeless incentive programs  Financial requirement that 5-7.5% of profits be re-invested in the community  Enhanced care management of special needs population will include oral health  Quality aspects to rate development - Health plan rates will rely heavily on encounter data and will have a value based payment structure  Dorothy Seleski comment: Lack of oral health specifics in CalAIM. ECM is specifically a medical benefit and community supports are specifically flexible supports on the medical side. Each of the initiatives have work groups dedicated to implementation. Oral health needs to raise a voice in public comment. Committee should look at the scope of initiatives under CalAIM for 2024 medical contracts and identify which ones should address oral health and strategize how the committee will comment on these initiatives.  Debra: Oral health is being included in the health plans requirements. Debra will follow-up and get back to the group regarding a list of proposed contract changes and oral health requirements when available. |  |

Liberty has implemented case management in California- all members who have co-morbidities automatically enrolled in the case management program and will receive assistance with authorizations  Two Registered Dental Assistants from the Improve Your Tomorrow program have graduated and are joining an office in Sacramento. Liberty offered a scholarship for training as a community health worker spreading oral health education.  Health Net has not attended any community events.  Community Resource Center has re-opened and will host a whole-person care day in July or August. Oral Health will be included at this event.  Health Net Provider outreach includes incentives to encourage maximizing dental visits  Health Net is available to attend events and offer support  Access member outreach- 45 English and Spanish virtual presentations on oral health and 3 onsite community events at YMCA Healthy Kids Day including distribution of dental kits and educational materials.  Access text campaign continues- 200,000 individual texts went out over the first 3 months of this year including text reminders to new members who have not accessed services  Access Provider outreach includes in person recruitment to find more specialists. 121 office trainings conducted within existing network including utilization benchmarks and discussing questions they have on 2021 benefit updates. |

Currently in the process of evaluating the work done so far by completing the Evaluation Report for the State. The grant cycle covering 2022-2027 begins July 1.</li> <li>The Office of Oral Health has given priority to school-based and school-linked programs. SCOHP has been working with stakeholders to brainstorm how school-based services can be expanded in Sacramento. Anyone can join the school-based subcommittee.</li> <li>Sacramento County has added a Registered Dental Assistant job class and postings for a continuous filing should be out soon.</li> <li>SCOHP is collaborating with partners at 2 upcoming events, COVID restrictions permitting. Sierra Health Foundation event is July 30 and Ready for Robla School Readiness event is August 6.</li> <li>SCOHP is preparing to launch a campaign to promote drinking fluoridated tap water in August.</li> <li>Next SCOHP Advisory Committee meeting is August 17 and all are encouraged to join.</li> </ul> |
